This spring, our intern Danielle Joseph had the opportunity to accompany Michelle and represent the ministry at several ladies' day events. In Danielle's words, here is a glimpse of what God is doing through these partnerships:

Ministry Report: IRSM Event Accompaniment

Throughout the month of March, I had the privilege of accompanying Michelle and representing Iron Rose Sister Ministries (IRSM) at three distinct ladies' day events. Each gathering was a testament to the hard work of the local congregations, featuring thoughtful planning and beautiful decor that successfully brought their chosen themes to life.

Cabot Ladies Day: Bold and Unashamed (AR)

This event excelled at fostering community through intentional connection. Between sessions, icebreakers and creative activities allowed the women to get to know one another on a more personal level, culminating in a fun evening of games.

Michelle's spiritual message was particularly impactful. She beautifully reframed "Bold and Unashamed", not as being loud or boisterous, but as having a quiet, steadfast confidence in Christ. She encouraged us to embrace what He has placed within us and to live out our purpose without reservation.

Cloverdale Ladies Day: Be Transformed (AR)

The decor for this event was elaborate and truly stunning. While we missed the first day's session, we joined the group for dinner and an evening of games, followed by a wonderful time of worship on Sunday.

Michelle presented a powerful lesson on the necessity of filling our hearts and minds with God's Word. Using a memorable visual demonstration with Kool-Aid, water, and bleach, she illustrated how focusing on non-spiritual things can cloud our judgment, while a refocus on Scripture transforms us into His image. True to her teaching style, she made the lesson "active," helping the women identify the lies of the enemy and respond with God's truth.

Daingerfield Ladies Day: If Jesus Met Me for Tea (TX)

Curated by Ju White and the women of Daingerfield Church of Christ, this event was a highlight of the month due to its incredible intentionality. The space was prepared beautifully for an afternoon tea, and every activity was woven together to support the theme.

IRSM served as the vehicle to help these women truly visualize what "tea with Jesus" would look like. We explored how He would receive us, what He would care about, and what He would want to share with us. The women were fully engaged in both Michelle's and my presentations.

Key Outcomes & Personal Highlights:

- **Deep Engagement:** The ladies were "tracking" with us all day, showing excited interest in IRSM's mission.
- **Ministry Support:** There was a significant response in terms of book purchases for small groups, personal donations, and even interest in our ministry earrings. More importantly, the women were just curious and hungry to know more about the ministry and how it could help them be intentional about their walk with God.
- **Personal Impact:** A major highlight for me was when a 12-year-old girl shared how much she appreciated my lesson, specifically hearing that Jesus cares about all of her. She also bought one of Michelle's books and was working on it during worship, which was such a heartwarming thing to see God moving through the heart of a child.

While every event this month was wonderful in its own right, the spirit-filled atmosphere and the seamless integration of the lessons and activities in Daingerfield made it a truly standout experience for the ministry. We give God thanks for Ju and her unwavering support of IRSM. Through her hard work, we continue to hear news of women who are being led to deepen their relationships with God, and this is what IRSM is all about -- a movement to draw women closer to God -- one woman, one child, one study group, one congregation at a time.
